Notes from Emmanuel's Choir Loft

From Music Director Michelle Carner

Our entrance hymn, "Worship the Lord in the Beauty of Holiness," was penned by the Irish Anglican clergyman John S. B. Monsell, author of eleven volumes of poems and over three hundred hymns. Tragically, Monsell died in 1875 after falling from his church roof during a construction project. This hymn combines the Irish and German in true Emmanuel fashion: the tune, "Was Lebet," is from the Rheinhardt MS, a German chorale book compiled in 1754.


