

## **Staff Reflection**

"Whoever is not Against Us is For Us" (Mark 9:40)



In today's reflection, Matt Ruttle, our Love in Action Coordinator, invites us to look inward and examine our own hearts through the lens of the Gospel reading from St. Mark. As we hear about Joshua and John feeling jealous and threatened by others who are prophesying and performing mighty deeds in God's name, we are reminded of how easy it is to fall into a similar mindset. In today's first reading from the Book of Numbers and in the Gospel reading from St. Mark, we hear from Joshua and John who are jealous of persons prophesying and doing "mighty deeds" in God's name. These persons appear to Joshua and John as "apart" from their group, their band of followers. I am made aware through these readings of my own prejudices and jealousies, while trying to live out my faith and belief as a disciple of Jesus. I sometimes become envious or fearful when I perceive someone or some group of believers who appear to be doing "mighty deeds" in the Lord's name. I feel threatened. These persons and groups may not be a part of "my group" – my parish – my Catholic Christian faith.

I "hear" through God's Word today a call from the Lord to broaden my vision, my Faith horizons – to see His hand at work among all of his disciples and believers - even those persons "outside of our camp." God calls us all to do "mighty deeds" in His Name. Together as one people of Faith we move to praise, to adore, and to follow our good God on this journey toward the new and heavenly Jerusalem.

Well, it's not that we ever went away – we just haven't put out a newsletter in quite a while. We apologize, since we know we're only able to do what we do because of the generous support from our parishes and parishioners, and we want to keep you informed about the work you make possible for us to do.

We continue to help those in need in our area with utilities, rent and our monthly food pantry. We also help with furniture and appliances. Besides ordering furniture from the SVdP store, we also have our own crew that delivers furniture that's been donated directly to us or that we "scrounge" from various sources. The need is so great.

Oftentimes, our neighbors are faced with a roadblock in life that they just can't manage on their own. If they could just get past that hurdle, they could be off and running again.... A few months ago, for example, we received a call from someone we had never assisted before who was in need of help with a car repair. This is not something we typically help with, but as a home health care aide her car is her "lifeline". Faced with a sizeable estimate for a much-needed repair, one of our call takers took the time to speak to a friend who is a mechanic. As a result, the repair was completed for half of the original estimate; our neighbor paid for half the cost and we covered the other half. She was very grateful for the help and the opportunity to fend for herself again.

### A Good Time for a Good Cause

On June 6<sup>th</sup>, the Fifth Street Brewpub hosted a Fifth Street Brewpub "Gives Back" event which benefitted our Emmanuel SVdP Conference with a share of the net proceeds for the night, along with funds from raffles and split-the-pot. Many of our members came out to "work" the event, selling tickets and raising awareness about what our conference does. We were also blessed to have live music at the event generously provided by Ludlow Creek, a great local band featuring two of our own Vincentians. Many thanks to all the St. Gaspar Family of Parishes folks who came out to support us. It was a fun evening of fellowship while raising funds for our neighbors! It was Fifth Street Brewpub's most successful "Gives Back" event to date. We raised over \$1700 for our conference that will directly benefit our neighbors in need!

### This Quarter by the Numbers

In the months of April through June, we assisted our neighbors in need with:

- \$5414.00 in rental assistance to keep 29 families in their homes
- \$10,895.00 in utility assistance to keep 86 families' electricity, gas & water on
- \$4293.24 in furniture assistance to improve our neighbors' quality of life; and our moving crew made deliveries to 28 households
- We also gave food to 182 people from 94 families and made 26 deliveries to those who could not come to our pantry. *We thank you for your support!*
