

In today's gospel, "One of the scribes came to Jesus and asked Him, "Which is the first of all the commandments?" Jesus replied,

"The first is this: Hear, O Israel!

The Lord our God is Lord alone!

You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul,

with all your mind,

and with all your strength.

The second is this:

You shall love your neighbor as yourself.

There is no other commandment greater than these."



Notes from Emmanuel's Choir Loft

Today, at the Offertory, you will hear a "full proper" antiphon from the collection of Gregorian chant, which is our heritage as Catholics. Found in medieval manuscripts well over 1100 years old and sung throughout the centuries on this particular Sunday of the Church year, its text is taken from Psalm 103: "Bless the Lord, O my soul, and never forget all He has done for you, and your youth will be renewed like the eagle's." The music was written to "sound" like what the words mean. Notice especially the long and lively melody on the word "juventus," which means "youth," and hear the joyful mode chosen by the composer. Fr. Samuel Weber has masterfully adapted the chant for the English version while respecting the musical integrity of the original.




