The St. Gaspar Family of Parishes and the Knights of Columbus Marian Council will host The Eucharistic Miracles of the World exhibit, cataloged by 15-year-old Blessed Carlos Acutis. The exhibit includes 120 displays. The display pieces will be divided among Emmanuel, St. Joseph, Precious Blood, St. Paul, and St. Rita.

Carlos' exhibition presents a selection of the main Eucharist Miracles which occurred over the centuries in various countries and are recognized by the

Church. At this exhibit, you will learn about amazing Eucharistic Miracles in the Church's history cataloged by 15 year-old Blessed Carol Acutis, who said the Eucharist was his "highway to heaven." In these special cases, a second miracle occurs after the bread and wine are changed into our Lord's flesh and blood. What normally continues to look like bread or wine after the consecration then appear as human flesh and/or blood.

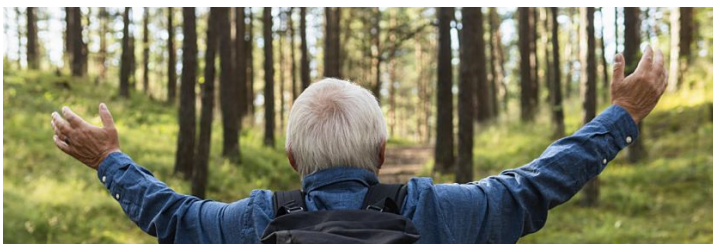

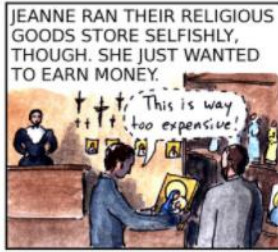

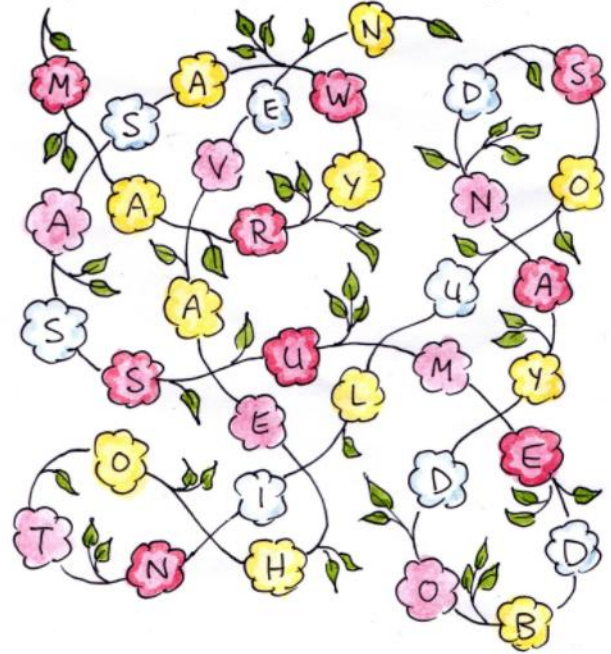
