In Luke's gospel we hear Jesus telling us about his second coming.

"Beware that your hearts do not become drowsy from carousing and drunkenness and the anxieties of daily life, and that day catch you by surprise like a trap. For that day will assault everyone who lives on the face of the earth. Be vigilant at all times and pray that you have the strength to escape the tribulations that are imminent and to stand before the Son of Man."

Jesus expects us to be vigilant. To be ready for his second coming. Not to give into the way of the world of drunkenness and carousing. Jesus expects us to exercise self-discipline in our actions with others. Jesus also mentions the anxieties of daily life. That you and I must work and pay taxes and this can cause anxiety. Even if we work, we are still called to draw close to Jesus and pray.

You can be sure that Jesus will come again to this earth but He will come as judge. He will judge our lives. This may be a more stern disposition than we're used to. At this time on earth we're living in, Jesus is merciful and He's giving us a chance to draw close to Him and His teachings. Jesus is encouraging us to make disciples of all nations. But someday that will come to an end and God will judge what we've done here on earth and what we haven't done.

Jesus just keeps telling us to be ready and to be vigilant. Advent is that time to practice readiness.


